## Yes! Bring recyclables in paper bags or cardboard boxes!

### RECYCLE SEPARATELY:

- Aluminum cans (empty beverage only)
- Corrugated cardboard
- Glass

### RECYCLE MIXED TOGETHER:

- Steel and tin cans, aluminum foil & trays (clean)
- Non-corrugated cardboard (cereal boxes, 12-pack soda/beer boxes)
- Paper food boxes and egg cartons
- Paper grocery bags
- Newspapers and inserts
- Paper milk and juice cartons (rinsed)
- Juice and soy milk boxes (Tetrapaks) (rinsed)
- #1 and #2 Plastic bottles, jars and containers (rinsed)
- WE DO NOT ACCEPT plastic film, packaging material, caps, dome tops or straws

## No! We DO NOT ACCEPT these items in the recycling:

- Styrofoam of any kind
- Bubble, shrink and food wrap of any kind
- Plastic bags & film
- Plastics #3, #4, #6, #7
- Paper towels, plates, napkins, tissues
- Prescription vials
- Disposable diapers
- Batteries of any type
- Light bulbs of any type
- Food-soiled products of any kind

\$3 per can (or bag)

### Mixed Recycling:

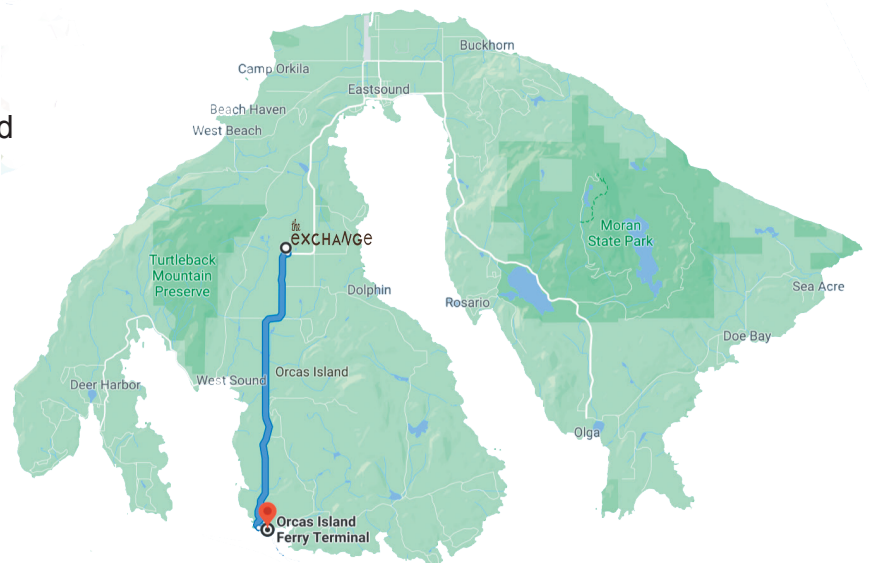
\$7 per can (or bag)
