- Corrugated cardboard
- Glass

RECYCLE MIXED TOGETHER:

- Steel and tin cans, aluminum foil & trays (clean)
- Non-corrugated cardboard (cereal boxes, 12-pack soda/beer boxes)
- Paper food boxes and egg cartons
- Paper grocery bags
- Newspapers and inserts, junk mail
- Paper milk and juice cartons (rinsed, caps off)
- · Juice and soy milk boxes (Tetrapaks) (rinsed, caps off)
- #1 and #2 Plastic bottles, jars and containers (rinsed, caps off)
- WE DO NOT ACCEPT plastic film, packaging material, caps, dome tops or straws

NO. We DO NOT ACCEPT these items in the recycling:

- Styrofoam of any kind
- Bubble, shrink and food wrap of any kind
- Plastic bags & film
- Plastics #3, #4, #5, #6, #7
- Paper towels, plates, napkins, tissues
- Prescription vials
- Disposable diapers
- Batteries of any type
- Light bulbs of any type
- · Food-soiled products of any kind
